To all our Patients,

COVID-19 Vaccine (Moderna) is now available for our established practice patients that have been seen in the past 2 years.

We are following IDPH guidelines and are including only select patients that are in the Phase 1B group and 1B+. Within that group there is a wide swath of eligible patients. If you fall in these groups, please call the practice or email us (info@suburbanprimarycare.com) to schedule the vaccine. We will vaccinate as many as we can given the supply at hand.

April 12 onwards, the State of Illinois will allow any one age over 16 to get the vaccine. We are hoping for a steady supply of vaccines by that time.

If you have already received your vaccine, please email us your CDC Vaccine card or the dates and type of vaccine you have received.

If you feel ill, we have on-site Rapid COVID and PCR, as well as Rapid Strep and Flu tests as well. As a side, please do not let your ANNUAL or scheduled appointments lapse.

There are many of you with chronic conditions that need assessment and evaluation including medication management and lab or radiology testing. Also, make sure you have completed your necessary screening interventions, including mammography and cervical cancer screening for some women, colorectal screening for age group 45-75 or those with prior polyps, lab tests for blood count, liver/kidney function, prostate test for certain men, diabetes, BP & updated Flu, Pneumonia vaccines to name a few.

You can email, call, or use our website to make office appointments and request testing orders prior to visits. We highly encourage Tele or Virtual Visits for minor conditions or questions regarding your health.

For those interested, a reminder that the practice has a weight loss, diabetes education and nutrition counseling program. This can be done with Virtual Visits as well. Our staff is fully vaccinated, and the areas and exam rooms are cleansed after each patient; social distance protocols are followed, and universal masking is mandatory.

We look forward to seeing our patients and making sure that your health concerns remain addressed during and after the pandemic. Let us hope this happens quickly so we can all return to some semblance of normality.
